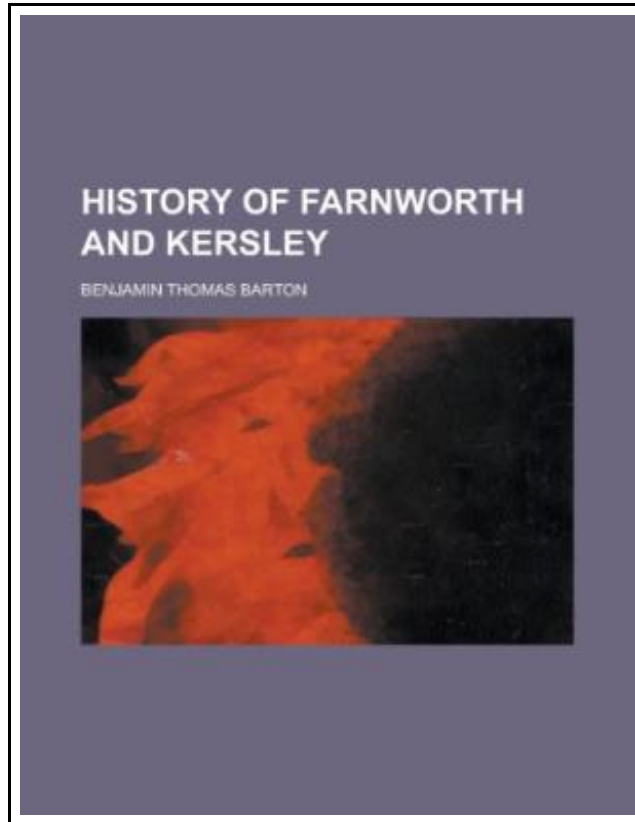

In May, 1846, Mr. Harrison Blair, Mr. Bowning, Mr. Edmund Parkinson, and Dr. J. L. Anderton were appointed vestrymen; and Mr. Robert Holme was appointed sexton, at a weekly wage of 4s. In November of the same year, it was decided that the management of the bells should fall upon the vestry, the ringers to receive 10 per year, with the usual fees and perquisites. On May 6th, 1850, it was resolved that the Bishop be requested to allow an increase of rent for each pew, according to the following scale: --Double pew, 102 sittings, at 3s. per sitting. Single 270 2s. Front gallery, 112 ls. Back 68 6d. The Hulmeian Trustees, as patrons, consented soon afterwards to the charges. Messrs. John Horridge, James Warburton, and Henry Sharp (surgeon), were appointed vestrymen, in place of Samuel Syddall, James Roscow, and Joseph Hulbert, deceased. In August, 1855, Mr. Leach was engaged to do the cleaning, colouring, and varnishing of the church. 204 Changes in the Composition of the Vestry. In this year also Mr. George Holme, the present sexton, and son of the late sexton, was appointed apparitor. In April, 1858, in the place of Samuel Tonge, James Howarth, and James Dootson, deceased, William Hargreaves, Joseph Leach, John Crompton, and Thomas Barrett were elected vestrymen; and on May 20th, in the following year, Thomas Bowden and James Tonge were appointed members of the vestry, in the place of T. B. Crompton and John...
