Bulletin 31 is a catalogue of West Virginia Scolytidae? and their enemies, but it is also something more than a catalogue. It gives rearing records and brief tabular accounts of the habits of 80 species of Scolytidae and of 88 species of the natural enemies of these destructive beetles. In considering parasites Mr. Hopkins has carefully distinguished between those found simply associated with the supposed host; those which he considers to be primary, and those which he considers to be secondary. Although the records would have been of more value had the reasons for these conclusions been given, the list nevertheless marks an advance in this direction.
